



Governors' Meeting Regarding Appointment of new Headteacher Friday 14 February 2014

Philip informed all governors that the Interview Selection Panel had met for the last 3 days, interviewed 3 candidates for the post of Headteacher and had offered the appointment to Martyn Silbley, Headteacher at Sherburn High School, for which he has verbally accepted.

The purpose of the meeting was to seek ratification from the Governing Body; all other criteria had been cleared (DBS/references). All Governors endorsed the decision.

Philip advised the governors that he would be meeting with the SLT, following the meeting, and a concurrent announcement, by email, would be made to staff at Tadcaster Grammar School and Sherburn High School on Monday 24 February 2014.

Keith Worrall confirmed, on behalf of the LA, the process was very fair and equitable and all three candidates were happy with the process.

Recognition was paid to the students who had been involved and praise and thanks were expressed for their participation. Philip thanked the whole Tadcaster Grammar community.

Alison Wadsworth, on behalf of the governors who were not involved in the Selection Process, thanked the governors on the panel.
